



Course Selection Instructions

Although the College makes every effort to accommodate each student's course choices, insufficient students choosing a course and/or grid line clashes may result in students having to re-select a course and/or course. You will be informed should this eventuate. It is *your* responsibility to ensure that your selections qualify you for any future course or desired career and that these courses are within your ability.

1. Choose SIX courses, as described in the *Course Selection Booklet 2010*. To select your first six courses, locate and circle course on the lists on Page 5/6, of this booklet and then write the name and Curriculum Council code for each course/course in the table provided on Page 7.

2. Choose TWO Reserve courses

To assist with the planning of choices, students are asked to choose two extra *courses* to act as "reserves" in case original selections cannot be offered. Make sure these are highlighted on Page 5/65 and written on Page 7.

Please note:

- **Approval:** On the basis of past performance and current achievement, this selection is:
 1. *Approved:* The student is considered able to cope with this course.
 2. *Not approved:* This course is considered inappropriate for this student and an *Inappropriate Course Selection* form is required and MUST be attached to this selection sheet. These forms can be obtained from the Hub.
- **Reserve courses/courses:** These courses are chosen in case up to two of the original six courses do not run, or cannot be studied due to timetable clashes. It cannot be guaranteed that these courses will run.

WACE Requirements - 2010

For students to graduate from secondary schooling they must meet the requirements of WACE or Western Australian Certificate of Education. The requirements fall under 3 categories: Course Completion; Course Achievement and English Language Competence.

Course Completion (eligibility):

- **Complete at least 20 course units.**
 - At least 10 units must be from Curriculum Council courses (including at least three two-unit combinations).
 - Up to 10 unit equivalents can be from endorsed programs.
 - Complete in their final WACE year (Year 12), at least one pair of course units from each of list A(arts/languages/social science) and list B (mathematics/science/technology).

Course Achievement:

- **Achieve an average of a C Grade or better.**
 - Across at least 10 course units from at least five courses (including at least three two-unit combinations i.e. 2A/2B or 3A/3B,

English Language Competence:

- **Complete 4 units of an English Course in Years 11 & 12**
- **Meet English language competence standard (work samples) or**
- **Pass ELC test**

WACE exams

- **Complete WACE exams for Stages 2 and 3 paired units**
