## What is the VETDSS Certificate II Kitchen Operations all about?

This qualification reflects the role of individuals working in kitchens who use a defined and limited range of food preparation and cookery skills. They are involved in mainly routine and repetitive tasks and work under direct supervision. It can be utilised by students wishing to enter into further cooking career pathways or it can simply be completed as a life skill certificate by students wishing to learn the basics in cooking and preparing meals.

Successful completion of this qualification provides you with the opportunity to work in kitchen operations such as restaurants, hotels, catering operations, clubs, pubs, cafes, cafeterias, coffee shops and institutions such as aged care facilities, hospitals, prisons and schools.
