Your son/daughter will be involved in a modified program that will introduce them to their courses for 2024, expectations, operations and facilities of the College.


Through undertaking modified tasks based around their 2024 courses, students will be able to confirm that their choices are appropriate to their needs and goals for the future.

Getting here

Students are requested to make their own way to and from the College - public transport is available, please check with TransGoldfields for pick-up times and locations. School buses drop off and pick up from Goldfields Arts Centre steps, while town buses arrive and depart from a block away on Boulder Road. Bike racks are available on the north side of the General Studies building and we suggest that bikes be secured by locks.

Where to go on arrival

Students are to assemble in the Student Services Building at 8:20am on Monday 11 December. From here students will be divided into mentor groups and given a tour of the College as well as their transition week timetable. Mentor teachers will ensure students know where their classrooms are and will provide them with information about course changes, uniforms and so on.

Uniform and Equipment

Students are expected to be in full school uniform. They can choose to purchase and wear their Eastern Goldfields College uniform from Green Door Gallery or else they need to wear the uniform from their current school. Students will also need to ensure they have all of their school equipment to enable them to complete the work set by teachers.

Absences and Change of Enrolment Status

Parents are requested to liaise directly with their child's current school regarding any absences during this week. Parents are also reminded that if their child, during the holiday break, elects not to return to school in 2024 due to employment or other training opportunities they are requested to contact Eastern Goldfields College directly for a formal Notice of Arrangement to be signed. This can be done at the commencement of the 2024 school year.
